Beautiful when filled with just a handful of flowers, they can be positioned together or individually.

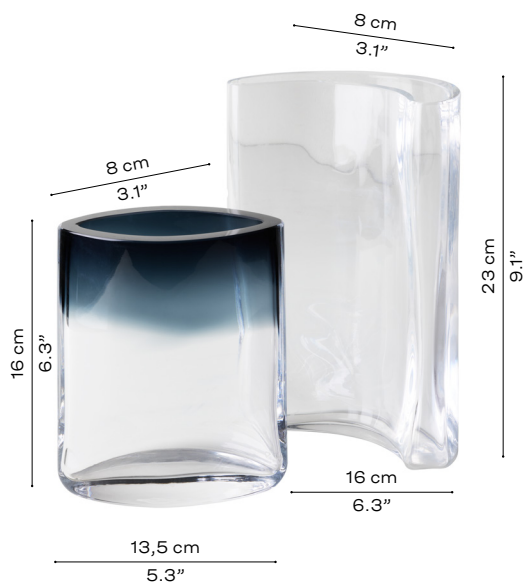
DESIGN

GRETHE MEYER (1918-2008)

Pioneering designer Grethe Meyer's creative talent was apparent from a young age. She studied architecture at the Royal Danish Academy of Fine Arts in Copenhagen, from where she graduated in 1947 as the only woman in her class. She founded her eponymous design studio in 1960, producing some of Denmark's most enduring design icons. Her simple, functional, beautiful and timeless idiom remains as relevant today as ever.

THE MATERIALS

Handblown into fixed moulds shaped as a moon and an eye, the Moon Eye glass vases require high levels of technical skill to craft. Smoked glass is used to make the smaller eye-shaped vessel, lending unique colour and visual appeal to each piece.
