Marshmallow Sofa

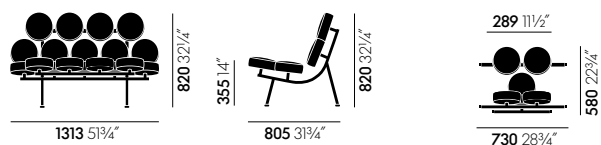
George Nelson's Marshmallow Sofa transforms the traditional sofa into a playful three-dimensional object with eighteen colourful cushions attached to a simple steel frame. Due to the unusual form and construction of the Marshmallow Sofa, it is one of the most extraordinary sofas in the history of design.

An extension element with six additional cushions can be mounted between two sofa units, making it possible to create a sofa of indefinite length. The individual cushions are upholstered with a robust vinyl cover.

Materials

- **Frame:** rectangular steel profiles, lacquered in black.
- **Upholstery:** 18 cushions.
- **Cover:** dark red, orange, green, purple and blue vinyl.
- **Extension element:** for mounting between two sofas, frame with six cushions.
